

Is outdoor power safe at home







Overview

When running power outside, a GFCI-equipped outlet ensures safety, and is required by code in all areas exposed to moisture, like the outdoors. When adding an outdoor outlet, be sure to choose an outdoor-rated, weatherproof model with built-in, high-sensitivity GFCI. Whether single or duplex, all exterior.

Follow these guidelines before, during and after operating a power tool outdoors: Read the tool's instructions, especially all safety warnings, before use. Plug the cord into a three-prong outlet on a three-conductor circuit. This provides the added safety of the neutral-to-ground connection provided by the third wire.

How can I protect my home from electric shock?

Prevent the risk of electric shock by keeping the following in mind when playing or working outdoors near power lines: Install your satellite dish as far from electric lines as possible, preferably at the opposite end of the house. Never let children fly kites, motorized airplanes or drones near power lines.
