Is Russia still a major gas exporter?

While Russian gas production has dropped in response, the country remains the largest holder of proven gas reserves and is still the second-largest gross gas exporter in the world, after the US. After a year of adapting to the shocking reduction in gas exports to Europe, Russia's ambitions to remain a significant gas market player have not dimmed.

Which company transports the most oil in Russia?

Transneft, the world's largest pipeline company, transports more than 85% of oil produced in Russia. The state-owned firm owns and operates nearly 43,000 miles of oil and natural gas pipelines in Russia, Asia, Europe, and Eurasia. 15 Rosneft's Vostok Oil project began construction in 2022.

Depending on the total value of oil and gas revenues each year, federal government income derived from the taxation of the extraction and export of oil and gas accounts for between one-third and half of.

How much oil does Russia export?

Russia exported about 199,000 b/d of crude oil to the United States in 2021, around 4% of Russia's crude oil exports for that year. Last year, Russia also exported 8.9 trillion cubic feet (Tcf) of liquefied and piped natural gas, 36% of the 24.8 Tcf of natural gas it produced.

In this commentary, the authors explore how Russia's export strategy has evolved over the past year in the face of mounting adversity and what it means for the world. In 2023, Russia exported an estimated 142 bcm of gas, down sharply from around 244 bcm in 2021.

Where does Russia export crude oil and condensate?

The majority of Russia's crude oil and condensate exports went to OECD Europe, which received almost half of Russia's total exports. However, at a country level, China imported the largest volume of Russia's crude oil and condensate exports in 2021.
